

How to Apply for Upper Campus International Students

Sierra Canyon School welcomes your application!

Please follow the instructions below and contact the Admission Office with any questions.

Sierra Canyon School enrolls new international students who wish to study at Sierra Canyon. Seventh grade candidates are welcome to apply if they plan to live in the local area with a family member for the 7th grade. Some 8th grade students (on a case-by-case basis) and all 9th-12th grade students will be paired with homestay families. Some on-campus boarding may be available.

Limited space is available for international students. Therefore, we strongly recommend that students submit applications early in the fall and before December 1. Applications received after December 1 will be evaluated on a space-available basis. Admission notification letters will be e-mailed on a rolling basis. Upon receipt of the enrollment deposit, signed contract Sierra Canyon will issue the I-20.

Online Application

The online application is available at ApplytoSC.org. Families may submit either the Sierra Canyon online application or the Standard Application Online (SAO). Both are evaluated equally.

Please complete the student and parent sections of the application and submit with a non-refundable \$150 USD application fee. Only complete applications will be accepted.

In addition to the online application, families must download and complete the **Homestay/Boarding Application**. It is available on the Sierra Canyon website. Please email the completed form to the Admission Office at:

Testing

Students, whose native language is not English must submit one of the following test results:

- TOEFL (scores of 85+ preferred)
- Junior TOEFL (scores of 700+ preferred)
- IELTS (scores of 6.5 - 8+ preferred)
- Duolingo (scores of 100+ preferred)

The Independent School Entrance Exam (ISEE) and the Secondary School Admission Test (SSAT) are not required of international applicants. Only non-native English speakers who have resided in the United States for 3 or more years should take the ISEE or SSAT exam.

Recommendations

Three letters of recommendation are required from the following current year's school representatives:

- English teacher
- Math teacher
- School administrator (if available) or third teacher recommendation

Grades

Official school grades are required from the past two years and the first term of the current year are to be submitted directly from the applicant's school to Sierra Canyon School, along with a translated copy in English. Information about the school's educational and grading system is also requested.

Interviews

Upon receipt and review of the completed application, a Zoom interview be scheduled by our office.

Financial Aid

Financial aid is not available to international students. Sierra Canyon does not offer scholarships.
